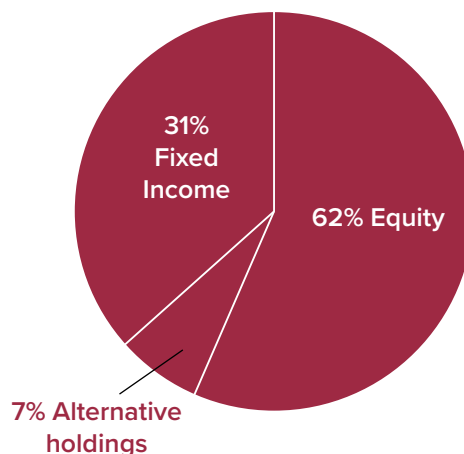

Markets / Economy Outlook for SC&RA Assets

Corporations have significant cash build up and capital spending is projected to continue to be strong. Gradual raising of interest rates and moderate inflation are viewed as positives for the broader equity markets. Volatility will remain high – as the 24-hour news cycle influences investor sentiment and market swings. Foreign policy issues related to China and Russia remain a concern. We are looking for high single digit returns for the equity markets.

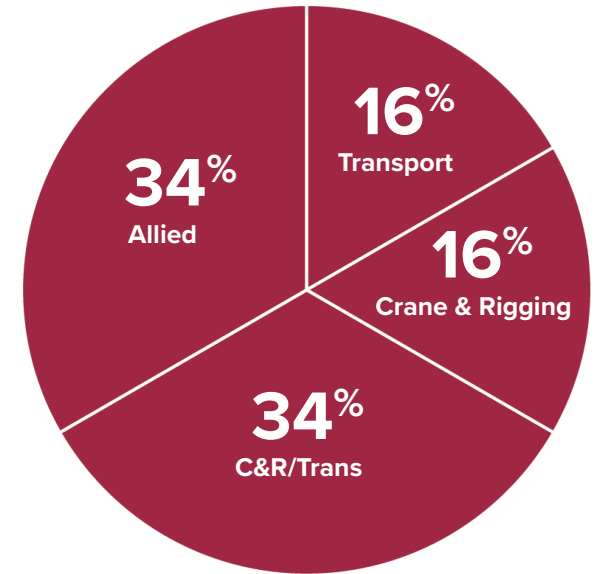
In summary we continue to favor

Membership

Membership continues its resiliency amid multiple industry challenges

Membership declined roughly 3.5% in 2021 vs. 4.9% in 2020 as membership tried to stabilize after the COVID-19 year. While just more than 100 new members were recruited during the year, many former and prospective member companies indicated they were looking to join SC&RA when their budgets and financial forecasts improved. SC&RA believes that a return to regularly scheduled meetings, new and improved members only products, and a better environment to conduct business will help the Association not only reach a 92% retention rate for the coming year but entice a number of companies to get more involved in the immediate future.

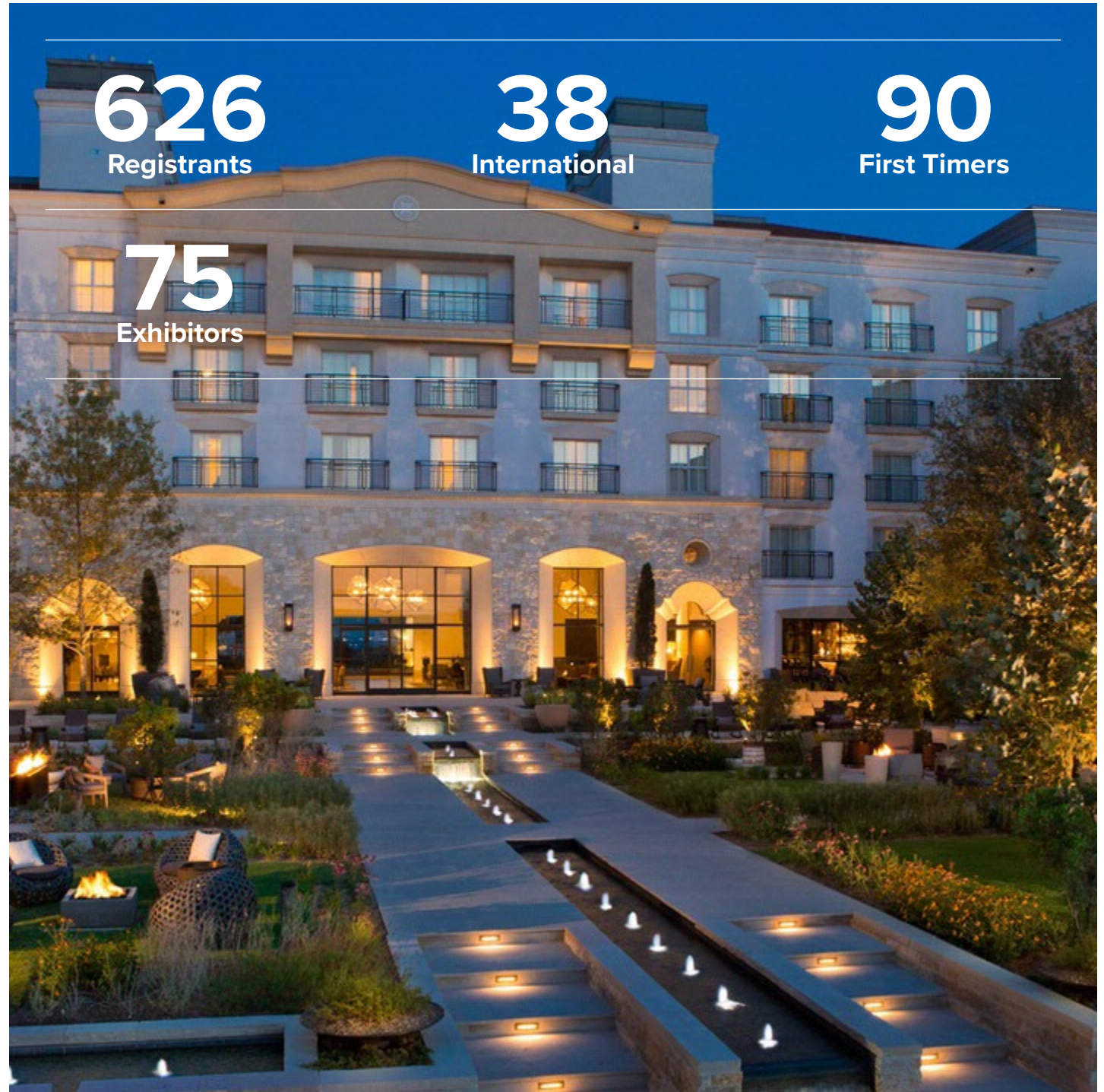

Birmingham, Alabama

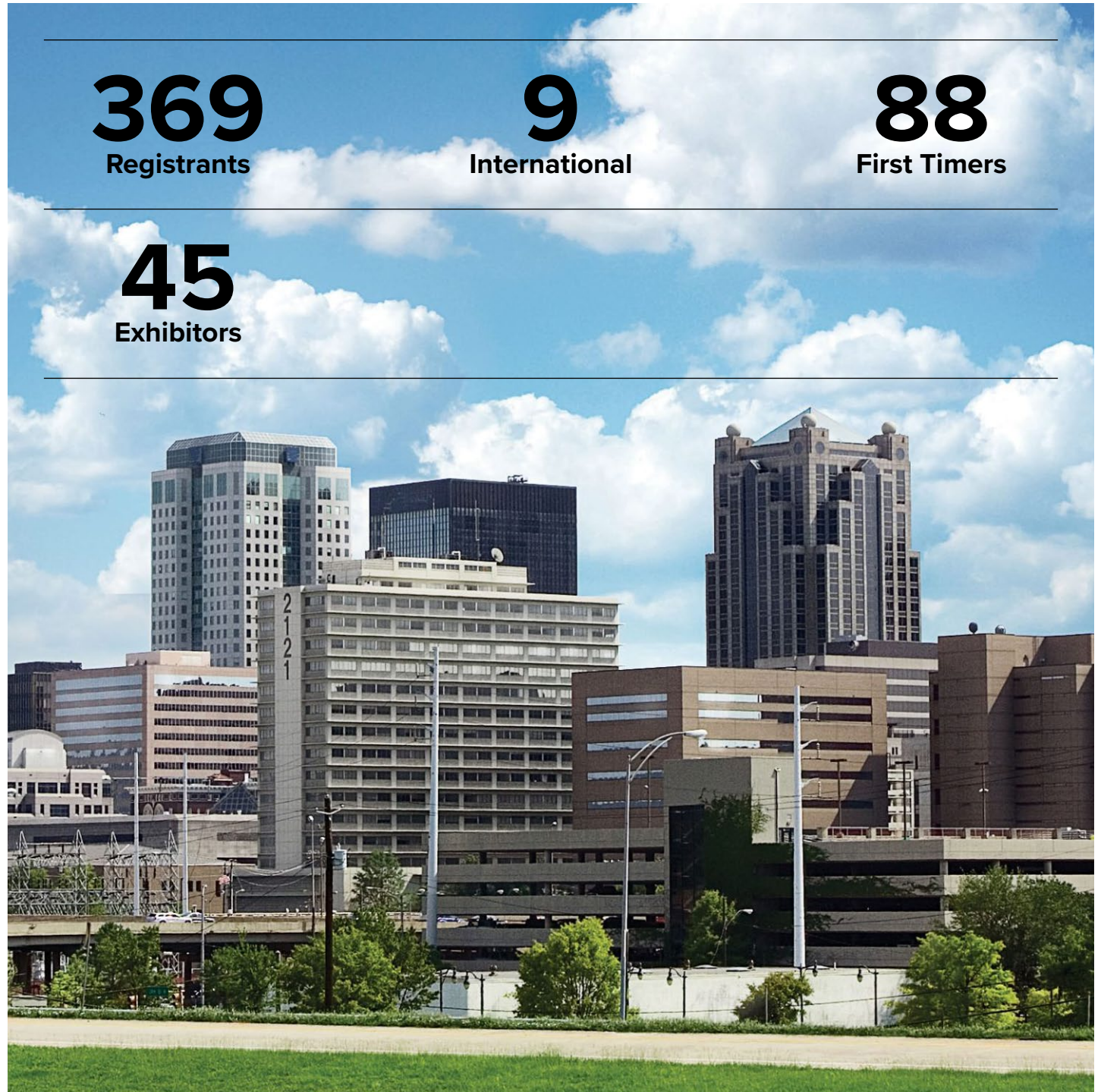
The Specialized Transportation Symposium was held June 22-24 in Birmingham, Alabama. This event was SC&RA's first in-person meeting since March of 2020. The event brought together specialized transportation professionals and government permitting officials to discuss safety, permitting harmonization, regulations, and best practices. Sessions focused on establishing a safety culture in your company; tips for winning contracts with the wind energy market; specialized transportation movement between North American borders; insurance and risk management; and best practices for specialized carriers in the courtroom. Three companies presented their winning Jobs of the Year entries: Transport Watson MTL; Emmert International; and Oxbo Mega Transport Solutions. SC&RA hosted the CTSO FOWG and virtually connected with various officials from MAASTO, SASHTO, NASTO and WASHTO, but attendance was minimal due to state travel restrictions due to COVID.

The Crane & Rigging Workshop was held in Chicago, September 14-16. Top managers, crane operators, safety directors, and operation managers were in attendance. Kicking off the event was a tour of local company, LGH. Busloads of attendees were treated to a tour of the LGH facility and enjoyed Midwest hospitality. The Workshop sessions focused on the practical and the potential as topics ranged from installation and stowing of swingaway jibs to electric crawler cranes. Other topics covered included: what you need to know about cyber liability; building company culture amidst transitional and generational change; B30.5 updates; how to protect your company in the courtroom; below-the-hook lifters; when your operator becomes a driver; and everything you need to know about fiber ropes. Companies presenting their winning Rigging Jobs of the Year were: Barnhart; Oxbo Mega Transport Solutions; and Fagioli SPA.

2021 Advocacy Wins

COVID-19 Crisis Command Center

Throughout 2021, the Association curated the latest state and federal COVID related information for members and posted to the SC&RA website page devoted to the pandemic. There, companies could find OSHA bulletins, as well as transportation news. This supported the essential critical infrastructure designation, fought for by SC&RA, and bestowed upon the crane, rigging and specialized transportation industry by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security the previous year.

Setting Standards with the U.S. Small Business Administration

SC&RA was approached by the U.S. Small Business Administration to assist with member involvement in the Small Business Advocacy Review (SBAR)/SBREFA panel on a possible Emergency Response standard. This proposed standard would apply to employers that designate employees to provide emergency response services that are currently covered by OSHA's Fire Brigades standard (29 CFR §1910.156) or are not specifically covered by another OSHA standard.

Power in Numbers

SC&RA joined the Construction Industry Safety Coalition (CISC) and was signatory on numerous letters fighting for its members on issues such as hazard communications, the CDC vaccine, and OSHA's Emergency Temporary Standard. The efforts successfully blocked implementation of OSHA's ETS for COVID-19 vaccination. The U.S. Court of Appeals for the 5th Circuit blocked implementation of the ETS, writing in a one-page order that the rule appeared to have "grave statutory and constitutional issues."

SC&RA, alongside over 70 other transportation and industry associations, supported Congress' passage and full funding of the bi-partisan Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA), the 5-year, \$1 trillion federal reauthorization of highway, bridge, and other federal programs critical to our industry.

SC&RA also joined the Keep Texas Trucking Coalition in support of Texas' successful passage of HB 19 that brought meaningful tort reform for the trucking industry to the state.

What Happens in California...

SC&RA submitted a letter to the California Occupational Safety and Health Standards Board requesting that they reconsider that proof load tests be based on manufacturers' load ratings for the conditions of use, while not exceeding 110 percent of the maximum load ratings for the boom on the crane. The Board responded that the matter is of critical importance to the safety of crane operations statewide and should not be "piggybacked" on to this rulemaking proposal. Future plans involve petitioning the California Board as set forth in section 142.2 of the California Labor Code.





Empowering Members to Protect Against Biased Agreements

Delivering a key tool in protecting members against unfair and biased agreements, a member task force developed, *Understanding Tower Crane Bare Rental Agreements*. This guide provides education on what specific terms mean, what clauses companies should be aware of, and how they affect your business and insurance liability.

Collaborating Internationally

SC&RA continues to work closely with like-minded groups around the world through the International Crane Stakeholders Assembly. Collectively, the group has released its fourth guidance document, *Mobile Crane Ground Preparation for Wind Farm Construction*, which is available to members on the SC&RA website or app.

Mobilizing for Mobile Cranes

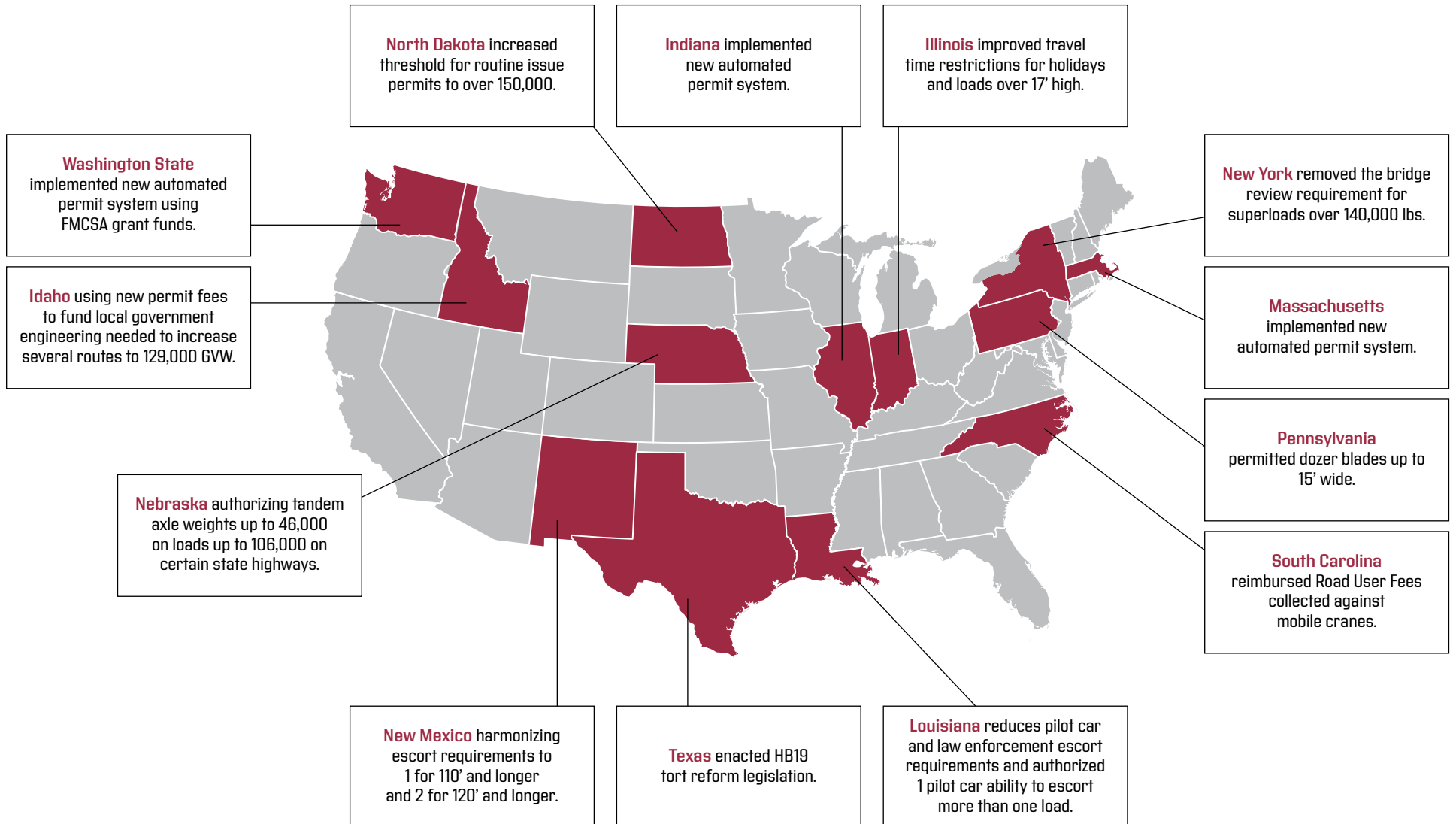
In a continued effort to advocate for mobile crane members, both the Crane & Rigging and Transportation Groups worked collaboratively in 2021 to address an increase in crane issues at the state level. In South Carolina, for example, SC&RA special mobile equipment operators scored a huge win when the state recognized that it was improperly taxing them through IRP/IFTA – when they were otherwise exempt.

\$61,000 Committed to Memorial and Corporate Named Awards in 2021

Douglas Ball Memorial

In 2021, the SC&RA established the Douglas Ball Memorial after his passing in March 2021. The former SC&RA Vice President of Transportation retired in 2015, but remained connected to the industry and passionate about the challenges facing companies in specialized transport.

Contributions from generous individuals and companies made in his memory totaled over \$17,000 and the first scholarship will be presented in 2022 to a recipient pursuing a career in specialized transportation.

The Robert (Bobby) Weyers Memorial

The Robert (Bobby) Weyers Memorial was established by TSP, Inc. in late 2021 and will be recognized in 2022.

NBIS Scholarship

NBIS renewed their engagement with the scholarship program and announced a three-year commitment of \$1,000 annually. The NBIS Continuing Education Scholarship will be awarded in 2022.

The Taylor Foundation
