## RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Entrants must submit an application online.
2. All members who joined prior to December 31, 2025 are eligible to enter the contest.
3. All entries must be received at the Association office no later than February 28, 2026.
4. All reports on injuries, illnesses, and lost calendar days will be kept confidential.
5. Requested information must be calculated from January 1 to December 31 of the contest year.
6. Only companies with statistics for the full twelve (12) months will be eligible for the competition.

### 7. Criteria

- o Incident Rate of 1.25 or less
- o Workers' Compensation Modification Rate of 1.0 or less
- o Zero (0) fatalities during the current program year (1/1/2025 - 12/31/2025)
- o Incident Expenses Frequency Rate of 1.0 or less

### 8. Documentation

#### U.S. Requirements:

- o SC&RA Work-Related Injuries and Illnesses Log
- o EMR on insurance broker/agent letterhead
- o MSHA - 4 quarterly reports (if applicable)

#### Canadian Requirements:

- o SC&RA Work-Related Injuries and Illnesses Log
- o Workers' compensation board injury reporting form for each province you do business in
- o Premium rate report for each province you do business in
- o MSHA - 4 quarterly reports (if applicable)

9. Incidence rates will be the primary formula for determining winners. When calculating incident rate, total hours worked includes all hours worked under OCIP programs

$$\text{Incidence Rate} = \frac{\text{Recordable Injuries/Illnesses} \times 200,000}{\text{Total Hours Worked}}$$

\*Recordable injuries/illnesses is defined as: every occupational death; every nonfatal occupational illness; and those nonfatal occupational injuries which involve one or more of the following: loss of consciousness, restriction of work or motion, transfer to another job, or medical treatment (other than first aid).

Recordable injuries/illnesses should be taken from the SC&RA Work-Related Injuries/Illnesses Log by adding columns G, H, I, and J.

10. *Incident Expenses Frequency Rate =  $\frac{\text{Incident Expenses for the Year}}{\text{Total Hours Worked}}$*  Ex.:  $\frac{\$50,000}{\$100,000} = 0.5$  Incident Expenses Freq. Rate

Incident Expenses Includes:

- All costs resulting from all work-related incidents (crane, rigging, transport, auto)
- Labor costs to recover and/or repair customer, public or company property/equipment
- 3rd party costs to recover and/or repair customer, public or company property/equipment

The following expenses **should not** be included

- Costs to defend lawsuits or other disputes related to an incident
- Emergency or other medical care for injured individuals
- Workers' compensation payouts to covered individuals

Total Hours includes:

- Actual field hours worked (not paid)
- 40 hours per week for all salaried employees

### 11. Insurance Loss Ratio:

Your company's GL lost ratio for the past five years must be provided on your broker's letterhead.

While this is not currently criteria for the contest, SC&RA is seeking additional data points to ensure our awards remain fair and competitive. *Information will only be used in aggregate when reporting to the Safety Education & Training Committee.*

Example:	<u>Effective Date</u>	<u>GL Loss Ratio</u>
	6/15/2025	0%
	6/15/2024	3%
	6/15/2023	0%
	6/15/2022	0%
	6/15/2021	1%

12. **Safety Improvement Awards** will be awarded to all entrants who show an improvement in their Incidence Rate from the previous year's contest entry.

13. **Zero Accidents Awards** will be awarded to all entrants who have zero recordable injuries and also meet the criteria noted earlier in item #6 for the contest year.

14. At the discretion of the Crane & Rigging Group's Safety Education and Training Committee, entrants may be required to submit verification of their contest information.

15. **Any company applicant found to have provided false or inaccurate information on the application will be prohibited from future considerations or participation in any SC&RA Crane & Rigging Group contest/award for a period of 5 years.**
