

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The Crane Operator Safety Award is awarded to crane operators who exhibit exemplary work achievements while accumulating **10,000** consecutive man hours while recording **zero (0)** accidents and incidents.
2. Operator must be certified by a nationally accredited crane operator testing organization.
3. Failure of a random or post-accident drug test during the program year (1/1/2025 - 12/31/25) is an automatic disqualification for participation in this year's awards program.
4. Company nominating individual must be a current member of SC&RA and have completed one year of membership in the Association.
5. All reports on injuries, illnesses and lost calendar days will be kept strictly confidential.
6. Minimum work hours: **10,000**  
All hours must be realized while working at current company. Individuals' primary duty during the time these hours were accrued must be as a crane operator.
7. Recordable injuries/illnesses: **zero (0)**  
Recordable injuries/illnesses is defined as: every occupational death; every nonfatal occupational illness; and those nonfatal occupational injuries which involve one or more of the following: loss of consciousness, restriction of work or motion, transfer to another job, or medical treatment (other than first aid). Recordable injuries/illnesses should be taken from OSHA Log 300
8. Total lost calendar days: **zero (0)**  
(Obtained from OSHA Log 300)
9. Total incidents **zero (0)**  
(Recordable on any company's OSHA log or property damage)
10. At the discretion of the Crane & Rigging Group Safety Education & Training Committee, entrants may be required to submit verification of their contest information.
