RULES AND REGULATIONS

The following questions should be answered based on the driver's performance while carrying out his/her duties. Do not include statistics pertaining to other individuals from your company.

1. The Driver Safety Award is awarded to drivers who:
 - o Exhibit exemplary work achievements over a 5-year consecutive period accumulating a minimum of 10,000 hours worked
 - o Record zero (0) accidents as defined by CFR Section 390.5, meaning occurrences involving a commercial motor vehicle operating on a highway in interstate or intrastate commerce which results in a fatality; bodily injury to a person who, as a result of the injury, immediately receives medical treatment away from the scene of the accident; or one or more motor vehicles incurring disabling damage as a result of the accident, requiring the motor vehicles to be transported away from the scene by a tow truck or other motor vehicle.
 - o Extraordinary, extenuating circumstances beyond the driver's control resulting in the above definition not being followed may be brought to the attention of SC&RA staff for consideration to remain eligible for award.
2. Company nominating individual must be a current member of SC&RA and have completed one year of membership in the Association.
3. Award recipient must be full time professional CDL licensed driver.
4. The 5-year consecutive period must be realized while working at current company. Individual's primary duty during this period must be as a heavy haul driver.
5. All applicants who meet the criteria outlined in aforementioned "Rules and Regulations 1 - 4" will be awarded the Driver Safety Award. To be eligible for consideration of the Driver of the Year Award, the "Optional Driver of the Year" questionnaire on the accompanying Application Form must be completed.
6. At the discretion of the Transportation Group Safety Education & Training Committee, entrants may be required to submit verification of their contest information.
